Photo of Mutual's Bob Hurleigh

Bob Hurleigh worked at Baltimore station WFBR before becoming the Mutual Broadcasting System's network news director. This undated photo of him (probably from the late 1950s) was sent to WFBR engineer Eddie Stover. It was autographed: "To Eddie: An engineer whose friendship I appreciate."

The Mutual Broadcasting System (MBS) started in 1934 and went out of business in 1999. Its many affiliates tended to be smaller stations, but it drew a big audience due to its popular programs such as *The Lone Ranger* and *The Green Hornet*.
