204A Transmitting Tube

Thanks to frequent donations of vacuum tubes, the Museum has thousands of receiving tubes on hand to use for repairing radios and TVs. Sales of surplus tubes brings in needed revenue.

The Museum also has quite a few larger transmitting tubes. This 204A tube has the military designation VT-22. Developed in the 1940s, it is a power triode used as an amplifier, modulator, or oscillator. It can operate at full power up to 3 Mhz.
